

1. SITE RULES

The Prague Harley Days 2019 – exhibition grounds venue (Prague 7 - Holešovice)

A. Introductory provisions

- i. These Site Rules are a guideline issued by the Promoter of the event, **Klasik Moto a.s.**, Reg No. 25735781, with registered office at U Šalamounky 41, 158 00 Prague 5, registered in the Commercial Register administered by the Municipal Court in Prague Section B, File No. 5781 (hereinafter the “**Operator**” and/or “**Organiser**” and/or the “**Promoter**”), which determine the key binding rules applying to persons entering the area where the Celebration of the Prague Harley Days 2019 event (hereinafter the “**Event Venue**”) is held and utilising equipment located at the Event Venue (hereinafter the “**Site Rules**”) at the time the aforementioned event is held, i.e. from 5 July 2019 (Friday) to 6 July 2019 (Saturday) inclusive, and also at the time of construction and removal of the event.
- ii. The purpose of the Site Rules is particularly to assure protection of safety, fire prevention, hygiene and protection of health and property at the Event Venue and also to assure the ideal conditions for the smooth progress of all sports, social and/or cultural events (hereinafter the “**Events**”), which will be held at the Event Venue.
- iii. For the purpose of these Site Rules, the Event Venue means the Operator’s visibly defined areas on the property of the exhibition grounds (Výstaviště) in Holešovice in Prague 7 (hereinafter the “**Event Venue**”).
- iv. These Site Rules only partially specify some provisions of the “Site Safety Rules” of the Výstaviště Praha exhibition grounds (hereinafter the “**SSR**”) valid from 1 January 2015 for the entire Event Venue. All persons entering the Event Venue are required to adhere to the SSR.
- v. By entering the Event Venue each person agrees with the terms stipulated in these Site Rules and these Site Rules become binding for every person entering the Event Venue from the moment of entry, throughout the entire duration of their stay at the Event Venue.
- vi. The provisions in these Site Rules particularly apply to persons entering the Event Venue on the basis of a special (i.e. direct and/or indirect) contractual relationship with the Operator and/or its contractual partners, e.g. employees or otherwise authorised and/or competent persons of suppliers, sub-contractors, promotional partners, companies providing servicing and/or other services (hereinafter the “**Staff**”).
- vii. All roads within the Výstaviště Prague 7 – Holešovice venue are certified on the level of public roads. All persons within the venue (i.e. drivers of motorised vehicles, motorcycles, cyclists and pedestrians) must adhere to the relevant provisions of Act No. 361/2000 Sb., “on traffic on ground roads” as amended.
- viii. Possessing or using drones or similar flying equipment/machines – whether automatic and/or remotely controlled, is prohibited throughout the entire venue. Visitors are also prohibited from carrying such equipment into the venue. There is a flight free zone over the entire Výstaviště Praha (Holešovice) venue and the surrounding area. The relevant competent person, authorised to do so by the Promoter of the event, permits exceptions to this rule.

B. Entry of persons into the Event Venue and inspection of adherence to the Site Rules

- i. The staff may only enter the Event Venue or its relevant defined zones with the Operator's consent and/or only during opening hours and/or only in compliance with the terms set out in these Site Rules. Any complaints may only be applied before entering the venue.
- ii. Adherence to and acceptance of these Site rules is monitored by the duly identified employees of the Operator and other duly identified persons authorised to do so by the Operator, the security service, or its duly identified employees, the competent employees of Výstaviště Praha (the exhibition grounds), fire patrols and, in the case of temporary electrical equipment, persons with electrical-engineering qualifications, and also the Czech Police and the Prague Municipal Police, within the scope of their statutory jurisdiction.

C. Staff training

- i. All staff must be trained in the field of fire prevention and OHS (occupational health and safety) before starting their activities at the Event Venue, in the manner corresponding to their activities. The supplier's and/or subcontractor's competent person is responsible for proper training.

D. Restriction of attendance / entry and/or removal from the Event Venue

- i. Persons who are evidently under the influence of alcohol or other addictive and narcotic substances, and also persons whose behaviour endangers the safety and/or health of persons and/or property located at the Event Venue, lose their right to remain at the Event Venue and may not be permitted to enter the Event Venue and/or may be removed from the Event Venue by the Organiser's employees, persons authorised by the Organiser and/or the security service. Persons who breach the rules set out in these Site Rules and/or fail to follow the instructions of the Organiser's employees, persons authorised by the Organiser and/or the security service also may not be permitted to enter the Event Venue and/or may be removed from the Event Venue.
- ii. Persons who are not permitted to enter and/or are removed from the Event Venue under the terms of these Site Rules, may have their entry to the Event Venue restricted by the Organiser or may be completely prohibited from entering the venue.

E. Activities subject to restrictions

- i. The following activities are prohibited without the prior consent of the relevant competent persons, i.e. particularly the fire patrols:
 - a) making an open fire;
 - b) welding or "cutting" using a flame;
 - c) "annealing" using a flame;
 - d) cutting metal, particularly by machine (e.g. using a so-called angle grinder), where there is any possibility of flying sparks occurring;
 - e) use of space heaters or other active heat sources (=heaters) regardless of their "power supply" (electricity, gas, etc.);
 - f) pumping and/or other disposal of fuels, lubricants, volatile, flammable and/or toxic substances;
 - g) storage of fuels, lubricants, volatile, flammable and/or toxic substances;

- h) storage and handling of pressurised containers.
- ii. Only the persons duly professionally trained to carry out these activities may perform the aforementioned activities under the terms set out in the fire rules, after they receive the prior consent of the relevant competent persons.

F. Final provisions

- i. The rules set out in these Site Rules may be further supplemented by rules applying to individual events held at the Event Venue or its areas. Such supplementary rules will always be appropriately published at the Event Venue and/or its area, or will be available from the Operator or the security service and the staff are required to adhere to it.
