

FIRE ALARM GUIDELINE – PRAGUE HARLEY DAYS 2025

- i. Any person who sees a fire at the event venue is required to attempt to extinguish it. If the fire cannot be extinguished, or if it is clear that this person will be unable to extinguish the fire by himself, the event organisers or the fire patrol must be notified and will always report the fire to the Fire Brigade of the Capital City of Prague, or the fire must be reported by the person who first saw it.
- ii. The fire alarm is given in individual buildings and stands by electronic fire alarm sirens, in smaller structures where no electronic fire alarm is installed, by shouting “Fire”. If technically possible information is provided by the sound systems of individual structures.
- iii. After a fire alarm has been given all activities in progress will be interrupted and all persons will leave the individual buildings and tents after notifying others. Individual persons follow the instructions of the fire patrol commander and the instructions of the event organisers until the fire brigade unit arrives. All persons are required to help extinguish the fire, or during evacuation of persons or material.
- iv. An alarm, as a result of which the venue must be exited, is announced using the venue sound system speakers in several languages.

Evacuation announcement due to bad weather:

*Warning, important announcement for all visitors to the Prague Harley Days Event – due to the exceptionally poor weather we are forced to interrupt the programme.
Please leave the event venue by foot. Do not attempt to leave by car and/or on motorbike – this is strictly forbidden. Please follow the instructions of the organisers. The programme will continue after the situation improves.*

Evacuation announcement for technical-operating reasons:

*Warning, important announcement for all visitors to the Prague Harley Days Event – we are forced to interrupt the programme for technical-operating reasons.
Please leave the event venue by foot. Do not attempt to leave by car and/or on motorbike – this is strictly forbidden. Please follow the instructions of the organisers. The programme will continue after the situation improves.*
